1. General observations

Each family unit given a specific area to build Words "next to them" found 28 times
Those living in city worked where they lived – 28
This would cut down travel time
Make it easier for the whole family to be involved Working next to a neighbor, building community pride

Providing protection where they lived

2. The Workforce

God takes note of those who are willing to serve
And those who were not willing to serve - 5
Great variety of people involved in the project

Priests – 1

Rulers – 9, 12, 14-19 (But not nobles of Tekoa – 5)

Both men and women were involved - 12

Professional craftsmen (goldsmiths, apothecaries) – 8

Merchants – 32

Commuters from Jericho, Tekoa & other towns – 2, 5, 7

Some noted for doing more than expected

Baruch is said to have "earnestly repaired" - 20

Workers from Tekoa took on additional section – 27

II. An Organized Plan

Sections from Gate to Gate

1. Sheep Gate - 1-2

Priests worked on the sheep Gate – 1 Important to them – where sheep entered for Sacrifice

Two towers were included in this section – 1
Families listed to were next to the Priests
Men from Jericho and Son of Imri

2. Fish Gate - 3-5

Builders are listed by family - 3-4

Men from Tekoa - but not their nobles - 5

3. Old Gate (Yeshanah) - 6-12

Those who repaired the gate – 6

Those connected with Governor of Province – 7

Those repairing section of city wall – 8

Extending to the Broad Wall

Next the ruler of half district of Jerusalem - 9

Next family Harumaph opposite his house – 10

Next section including Tower of Ovens - 11

Next ruler of 2nd half of Jerusalem -12

With his daughters

4. Valley Gate to the Dung Gate – 13

Hanun & people from Zanosh repaired section

5. Dung Gate - 14

Son of a ruler rebuilt this gate

6. Fountain Gate - 15-25

This section was at the City of David – 15-16

Tombs of David were in this section
Next section repaired by the Levites – 17-19
Next section was the section of Priests - 20-24
Then home of the king at court of guard – 25

7. Water Gate - 26-27

From gate to Projecting tower & wall of Ophel

8. Horse Gate – 28-29a

Priests repaired near where they lived

9. East Gate – 29b-30

The keeper of the gate did repairs

2 families repaired from gate to next gate – 30

10. Muster (Inspection) Gate – 31-32

Repaired gate & section to Sheep gate
