The Crisis Begins Esther 3

I. Haman & Mordecai – 3:1-5

- 1. Who is Haman 1, 8
- Haman, son of Hammedatha the Agagite
 Jewish tradition links him to King Agag 1 Sam. 15:8
 King Saul is to destroy Amalekites for what they
 did to Israel 1 Samuel 15:1-8
 King of Amalekites who attacked Israel- Ex. 17-8-16
 Amalek attacked from the rear of Israel Deut. 25:17-19
 Amalek was the grandson of Esau Gen. 36:12
 Whoever Haman is, he is the Jews enemy Est. 3:8
- 2. His rise to power 1-2
 Promoted by the king to second seat
 King's edict all were to bow down to him
- Mordecai refuses to bow 2-4
 King's men question his refusal 3-4
 He told them that "he was a Jew"
- Men report to Haman 4-5
 Want to see if Mordecai will stand Tell Haman Mordecai is a Jew This enrages Haman even more

II. Haman's Plot - 6-11

- 1. He wants to annihilate all Jews 6 Not satisfied to just kill Mordecai
- He chooses a date by lot (Pur) 7 In 1st month of year he picks 12th month God sovereignly controls casting of lots
- 3. He presents his plan to the king 8
 Note; he does not identify the people "certain people, scattered throughout empire"
 "their laws are different from everyone else"
 "they don't keep your laws"
 "It is not to your profit to tolerate them"
- 4. He offers to pay the cost 9
 If king will decree "Jews" annihilation
 He will pay 10,000 talents of silver (ab. 75 lbs)
- 5. King authorizes Haman's plot 10-11 Gives Haman his ring as official seal Promises government will pay the cost Haman can annihilate "this people"
- 6. No doubt Haman is prompted by Satan One of Satan's attempts to destroy Israel Keep God from bringing His Son as Savior

III. Edict is Delivered – 12-15

- Scribes wrote edict as directed 12 As they were commanded by Haman On the 13th day of the 1st month
- Wrote in name of the king, sealed with his ring
- 2. Sent letters to every province 13 All Jews, men, women & children to be killed

- Set 13th day of 12th month as the date
- 3. All people are to prepare for this day 14
- 4. King & Haman celebrated 15 But the city of Susa was perplexed
