I. Emptiness of Human Philosophy – 2:8

- 1. "Beware" a clear & present danger 8
 "See to it" be on guard
 You can be taken "captive"
- 2. Human philosophy
 - It is "vain" empty, devoid of truth note Ecclesiastes
 - It is "deceitful" based upon lies "According to human tradition" What man thinks
 - "According to elemental spirits of the world" Term speaks of what is basic to the world's system.
- Not according to Christ Christ is the full revelation of all that God is He is truth as is all of God's revelation Human thinking must be measured in the light of Christ - 2 Corinthians 10:5

II. Christ - Fulfilled the Law – 2:16-17

- 1. Don't seek righteousness by the law Proven that we cannot keep the law Christ came to completely fulfill the law Matthew 5:17-20
- 2. Don't let others judge you 16 In regard to observance of the law
- 3. God sees us in Christ 17 He has declared us righteous in Christ 2 Cor. 5:21; Rom. 8:1 We have died to the law – Rom. 7:4 We are now married to Christ – bearing fruit to God
- 3. Ceremonial law was a shadow 17
- Moral law (God's standard) fulfilled in Christ We are made the righteousness of God in Christ 2 Corinthians 5:21
- Ceremonial law is seen here in verse 16-17
- Dietary laws, festivals, new moon, sabbath These all were a shadow of things to come All pointed ahead to the Messiah Christ is the substance – reality with God
- Why hold to a shadow when you have reality 4. Sabbath is also in Ten Commandments
- Exodus 20:8-11 celebrates work of creation Take rest in God's finished work
- This is also a shadow of reality in Christ Hebrews 4 focuses on this fulfillment (Heb. 4:9-11) Our Sabbath is to rest in finished work of Christ's redemption

III. Mysticism Fails – Christ is Head – 2:18-19

- 1. Some seek God with mysticism
- 2. Living with asceticism & worship of angels Think this will bring them closer to God
- Let no one disqualify you 18 Because you lack asceticism And you do not worship angels Going on in detail about visions With pride in spiritual experiences
- Worship of angels is forbidden Exodus 20:3-4 – worship only God God's angels forbid worship – Rev. 22:8-9
- Revelation now is in Christ Hebrews 1:1-3 – He is our Head Truth is in Christ And what He has revealed to His apostles
- 7. True spiritual growth is in Christ 19 It comes in conjunction with His body "It is nourished and knit together Through its joints and ligaments" Growth is "growth that is from God" Ephesians 4::7-16

IV. Asceticism Fails in Spiritual Growth - 2:20-23

- Asceticism focuses on self-improvement 20 World's way of change We are no longer part of world's system Why do we think change comes that way Self denial, submitting to human means
- 2. Appears to be wisdom 23
 This is big in self-made religion
 Practice asceticism & severity to the body
- But no value in dealing with sin 23
 This means cannot stop indulgence of the flesh Answer will come in Colossians 3
