## New Life in Christ Colossians 3:1-4

## I. Risen with Christ – 3:1

 Our true position is "In Christ" Christ became our substitute He took our sins – paid the penalty He rose from the dead & ascended into Heaven God sees us in Christ – seated in heaven Ephesians 2:4-7

2. "If" that is true and it is – 3:1
This is a first class condition, meaning "since"
Or "in view of the fact" – Used for emphasis
Calls attention to the implications
We are now risen from the dead – 2:12-13
God sees us "in Christ" – on other side of death

## il. A New Perspective - 3:1-3

- Seek the things that are above 1
   That is where Christ is (He is our Life)
   Seated at the right Hand of God
   He rules over God's Kingdom
   If that is where He is & we are in Him
   If He rules over God's Kingdom
- 2. Set your minds on things above 2 Don't focus on things that are on earth This has to do with what we value And thus our purpose for living New Perspective – Christ & His kingdom World is passing away – 1 John 2:17 World will be consumed with fire 2 Peter 3:10-14; Book of Revelation Jesus spoke of our value system Matthew 6:19-21, 25-34 Paul also spoke in 1 Corinthians 3:9-15
- See your life as hid with Christ 3 "In Christ" you have died – Galatians 2:20 And your life is hidden with Christ in God Our life purpose is to serve Christ Live to bring glory & honor to Christ 1 Corinthians 10:31

Our present life is "hidden" So it is not us who is seen but Christ in us Philippians 1:20-21

## III. A Glorious Future – 3:4

When Christ (who is your Life) appears

 "Appears" means seen for who He is
 No longer as humble servant
 No longer as despised and rejected
 No longer as suffering and crucified
 Appears in all of His glory – exalted King
 Revelation of Jesus Christ – Rev. 19:11-16

 Then you also will appear with Him in glory We will appear (be seen for who we are) In Him we are glorified sons of God – 1John 3:1-2 Romans 8:17-18 – we will be complete in Christ Our future prospect ought to motivate us now
