# Dealing With Relationships Ephesians - 6:1-9

## I. Children Learning to Submit – 6:1-3

Submission one to another - 5:18
 This is basic in an orderly society
 With beginning of sin came rebellion
 Adam & Eve chose to act in disobedience to God
 Humans chose to act prompted by their own will
 Result was disorder and brokenness in our world

2. God's answer is in the redemptive work of Christ Forgiveness of sin and new life in Christ Enablement for this new life comes with gift of the Spirit

Holy Spirit enables us to submit our will to God Followed by submitting to one another in relationships

3. This begins in our families
Wives and husbands – Eph. 5:22-33
Next we come to Children & Parents

Children are born with a sinful nature – Psa. 51:5
 Self-will & rebellion is in all of us

Order in the home calls for submission of wills First commandment in God's 10 – Ex. 20:12

"Honor your father and mother"

Learning to obey those in authority over you

This command had a promise attached

"That it may go well with you and you may live long in the land"

Submission & obedience brings good consequences

Parents should teach their children to know God When they come to know God they need to know His provision

Believing children have the Holy Spirit to help them submit

Submitting to one another is part of family living

# II. Father's Challenge in Training - 6:4

- 1. Fathers named here as responsible What is said applies to mothers also
- 2. Do not provoke your children to anger
  Things that may provoke them to anger
  Inconsistent with what is required
  Favoritism among children
  Inconsistent with parents example
  Expectations too high for specific child
  Child's age & ability to perform
- 3. Training children in obedience & God's truth Helping them to learn to obey what God says

## III. Bondservants Obeying Masters - 6:5-8

 Spiritual issue of submission goes to work with us "Obey your earthly masters with fear & trembling" - 5 "Serving with a sincere heart, as you would Christ" You represent your Lord as you serve in your work "Not by way of eye-service, as people pleasers" – 6 "As bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart"

This position is God's will for you to represent Him "Rendering service with a good will as to the Lord" – 7 "Not unto men" Your serving God as you serve men

Your Lord will reward you for what you do – 8
 "Knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he
 will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a
 bondservant or is free"

God will reward His faithful servants wherever they serve

#### IV. Masters Consider Your Workers - 6:9

Believing masters have the same Lord

Be considerate, sensitive to your workers needs Stop threatening

"Knowing that He who is both their Master and yours is in heaven"

You will give account unto your Master And there is no partiality with Him
