God Speaks to Jeremiah The Lamenting Prophet

I. Testimony of Jeremiah - 1:1-19

- Jeremiah and his period 1:1-3
 He was the son of Hilkiah, a priest
 He lived in Anathoth, in land of Benjamin
 Latter days of Josiah King of Judah
 Time also of King Jehoiakim & Zedekiah
 Until time of captivity of Jerusalem
- God's Call to Jeremiah 1:4-10
 God set him aside to be a prophet before birth Jeremiah protested as a youth & non-speaker
 God would not allow him to object
 God would speak through him & be with him
 No need to be afraid of the people
 Lord put out his hand & touched his mouth - 10
- 3. His mission was to speak for God 1:9-10 Ministry to nations and kingdoms
 To pluck up and to break down
 To destroy and to overthrow
 To build and to plant
- 4. Jeremiah's visions confirming his call 1:11-19 Vision of an almond branch – 11-12 God keeps watch over response to His Word Vision of boiling pot from the north – 13-19 God will bring trouble to Judah for failure to obey His will is they submit to God's discipline in exile

II. God's Message to Judah - 2-45

- God's indictment on Judah 2-20
 They have forsaken the Lord 1-4 (note 2:12-13)
 No repentance will bring judgment 5-6
 Judah's evil and idolatry 7-10
 Unfaithful to their covenant with God 11-20
 Listened to lying prophets 14:13-16
 Persecuted God's prophet 20:1-2
- God's warning of impending judgment 21-25
 Jerusalem will fall to Nebuchadnezzar 21
 Seventy years of captivity 25
 Trust God and He will restore you to your land
- 3. Conflict with lying prophets 26-29
 Hananiah predicts deliverance in 2 yrs. 28:1-4
 Jeremiah & Shemaiah conflict over 70 yrs 29
- 4. God promises a New Covenant 30-33
 Messiah will bring reconciliation with God
 New Covenant brings inward transformation 31:34
 God's promises to His people will be fulfilled 32-33
 Israel's land is secure & David's son will reign
- 5. God's judgment must fall on Judah 34-39
 Jerusalem will fall to Babylon 34-39
 Jeremiah's final warning to King Zedekiah 38:14-28
 If you surrender to Babylon your life will be spared 38:17

The city of Jerusalem will not be burned For fear of the people Zedekiah rejects his counsel

6. Jeremiah remains with those left in Judah – 40-45
He warns the leaders not to go to Egypt for help – 42
They flee to Egypt against Jeremiah's counsel – 43
Jeremiah tells them judgment will come in Egypt – 44
Jeremiah shares with Baruch destruction of Jerusalem –
45

What God has built He is now going to destroy But as Isaiah said (Isa. 44-45) Cyrus will restore the Temple

 Refusing to surrender he is captured
 His sons are killed before his eyes & officials also
 King's eyes are put out & he is put in prison in
 Babylon
- 2. Temple & Jerusalem burned with fire 12-23
- 3. People taken into exile in Babylon 24-30 Lamentations comes with fall of Jerusalem
