Troubled on Every Side Genesis 37:1-40:23

I. Joseph's Position - 37:1-11

- 1. Favored by his father 1-3
 Perhaps because he was the son of Rachel
 Perhaps because he reported on his brothers
 His father made him the coat of a prince
- 2. Hated by his brothers 4
 Jealousy and envy prompted hatred
- 3. Revelations from God 5-11
 Joseph's dreams foretold future exaltation
 Dream of the sheaves of grain 6-8
 Dream of sun, moon and stars 9-10
 His brothers hatred only increased

II. Joseph in the Pit - 37:12-36

- Joseph sent to find his brothers -12-17
 He was to report back to his father
 He had to search until he found them
- 2. His brothers plot against him 18-24Their desire is to kill himReuben intervenes & they put him in a pit
- 3. Judah suggests they sell him 25-28 Sold him as a slave for 20 pieces of silver
- 4. They tell their father he was killed 29-36 His blood covered coat is their proof Jacob mourns for his son Joseph

III. Judah's Shame - 38:1-30

- Judah marries a Canaanite 1-5
 He left his brothers, met a Canaanite woman
 Judah and Shuah had 3 sons
- 2. Judah's first son married Tamar 6-7 Lord took his life because he was wicked
- 3. Second son refused to take his wife 8-10 The Lord took his life also
- 4. Judah asked Tamar to wait for 3rd son 11
- 5. Judah's wife died & he was comforted 12
- 6. Tamar played the prostitute 13-18
 Shelah was grown but not given to her 13-14
 Judah approached thinking she was a harlot –
 15-16

He pledged to send her a young goat – 17-18

- 7. Tamar becomes pregnant 18-23

 Judah unable to pay his debt to her 19-23
- 8. Judah learns Tamar is pregnant 24 He wants her to be put to death
- 9. Judah learns he is the father 25-26 He acknowledged his wrong
- 10. Twin sons born to Judah & Tamar 27-30 God's grace will include them in Judah's line Judah has no other sons

IV. Joseph and Potiphar – 39:1-23

- God blesses Joseph & Potiphar 1-6
 As a servant he was faithful, was promoted
- 2. Potiphar's wife tried to entice him 7-12 Joseph refused her appeal, ran from her
- 3. Potiphar's wife lied about Joseph 13-18 She used his garment to support her lie
- 4. Potiphar put Joseph in prison 19-20 He believed his wife's lie
- 5. Lord blessed Joseph in prison 21-23 Keeper of the prison made him a supervisor

V. Joseph in Prison – 40:1-23

- 1. Joseph had two special prisoners 1-4 Pharaoh's butler and baker are under Joseph
- 2. Both men had dreams in same night 5-8 They were troubled as to their meaning
- 3. Joseph interprets butler's dream 9-15
 Within 3 days he will be restored to his position
 Joseph asks him to remember him to Pharaoh
- 4. Joseph interprets baker's dream 16-19 Within 3 days he will be hanged
- 5. Dreams come true as predicted 20-23 Butler doesn't remember Joseph to Pharaoh
