Things that Matter Matthew 19

I. Marriage & Singleness – 19:1-12

- Jesus departs from Galilee 1-2
 Begins to move into Judea, toward Jerusalem
 He is still on the other side of Jordan River
 Great multitude follows seeks healing
- 2. Pharisees come testing Him 3
 Still looking for charges against Him
- Still looking for charges against Him

 3. Issue is on marriage & divorce 3-9
 What is legal cause for divorce? 3
 Passage in the Law Deuteronomy 24:1
 Some took that to mean "any cause"
 God's plan is faithful commitment 4-6
 God made one male & one female
 They are joined together as "one flesh"
 Don't separate what God has joined
 Why did God provide for divorce in law 7-8
 Hardness of man's heart Knowing he will rebel
 To protect and provide for the divorced wife
 Jesus gives His word on the issue 9
 Marriage commitment is to be honored
 Sexual unfaithfulness violates this commitment
- 4. Disciples: "Not good to marry" 10-12
 This is a valid choice but not for all 11
 It requires chastity sexual abstinence 12

II. Value of Children – 19:13-15 Children are part of God's creative plan

- People were bringing children to Jesus 13
 Sought prayer & His blessing for them
 Disciples saw an annoyance & rebuked them
- 2. Jesus allowed them to come 14-15
 They have value as a part of His kingdom
 He put His hands on them to bless them

III. Eternal vs. Earthly Values - 16-30

- Man came seeking eternal life -16
 This is a good desire & seeks "good" teacher
- 2. Questioned his view of Jesus 17 Only God is truly good Do you believe that Jesus is God?
- 3. What does the law require 17-20 Man asks which commandment Jesus gives a brief summary
- 4. Man says "I have done it? 20 "What do I lack"
- 5. If you truly want to be perfect 21
 Sell what you have & give to the poor
 The poor are your neighbors
 Jesus said "Come and follow me"
- 6. Man went away in sorrow 22

He had great riches Seems to lack also in covetousness

- 7. Jesus uses this to teach disciples 23-26
 Riches can be a hindrance spiritually
 Can trust in possessions rather than God
 Disciples' response indicates a common problem
 Jesus said "With God all things are possible
- Peter wants reassurance 27
 "We have forsaken all & followed you"
 We have done what rich man wouldn't do
 "What shall we have in eternity note v. 21
- 9. Reassures him of compensation 28-29
 Rule with Christ in eternity 28
 12 disciples sit on thrones over Israel
 Compensated 100 times over 29
 Shall inherit everlasting life -29
- 10. Our values are not God's 30Some we may put first may not beAnd some we rank last may be first
