Moses Meets God Exodus 3-4

I. God's Call to Moses - Ex. 3:1-6

- Meets God at Burning Bush 1-6 Shepherding sheep for father-in-law - 1 At Mt. Horeb, the Mount of God Glory of God appeared in burning bush - 2 Angel of the Lord in a flame of fire Yet the bush was not consumed Moses attracted to this unusual sight - 3
- God spoke to Moses from the bush 4-6
 Moses is in presence of the Holy God 5
 Covenant God of Abraham, Isaac & Jacob 6
 Moses in awe before presence of the Holy God

II. God's Promise to Deliver – 3:7-12

- God will deliver His people 7-9
 God saw their need & heard their cry - 7
 God will intervene for His people - 8
 He will bring them out of Egypt in deliverance
 He will bring them into a land of milk & honey
 God has seen the Egyptian oppression - 9
- God will use Moses as deliverer 10-13
 Moses questions his qualifications 11
 God assures him of success 12
 Your people will serve God on this mountain

III. God Reveals Himself – 3:13-16

- Moses lacks knowledge of God 13 Would not know what to say about God Would not even know God's name
- 2. God is The Great I AM 14,15
 Yahweh, Jehovah is the God of Israel He is the eternal self-existing God He is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob He is unchanging God, faithful to His covenants Jesus used this name also – John 8:56-59

IV. God's Directives to Moses - 3:16-22

- 1. Gather elders of Israel together 16-18 Tell them about your encounter with God Tell them about God's promised deliverance They will listen and respond to your leadership
- 2. Request release from Pharaoh 18-20 Request a 3 day period to go worship God - 18 Pharaoh will not give you permission to go - 19 God will do miracles to make Pharaoh agree - 20
- 3. Gather wealth from Egyptians 21-22 God will give people favor with the Egyptians They will give the Israelites wealth God's people will not go away empty

V. Moses' Objections – 4:1-17

1. "They will not believe me" - 1-9 Note what God said in 3:18 God's mighty power will convince them Turning his rod into a serpent - 2-5 A leprous hand made well again - 6-8 Turning water into blood - 9

- 2. "I am not a gifted speaker" 10-12 God will speak through Moses - 11-12
- "Send someone else" 13
 God is angry but will let Aaron speak 14-17
 God will speak to Moses & Moses to Aaron

VI. Moses Obeys God – 4:18-26

- 1. Seeks release from father-in-law 18 Return to seek welfare of his people
- 2. Moses & family returns to Egypt 19-20 He has God's rod & promise as he goes
- Release will require God's power 21-23
 Pharaoh will need to see miracles of God If he will not release God's son, God will take his
- 4. Moses must obey in circumcision -24-26 God requires complete obedience Cannot pick & choose what commands we obey

VII. Aaron Joins Moses – 4:27-31

- 1. God directs Aaron to go to Moses 27-28 He is to be a partner in this mission Moses fills him in on what God said & did
- 2. Moses & Aaron meet with elders 29-30 Aaron explained it & confirmed it with miracles
- 3. The people believed the message 31 They bowed in worship of God Thanking God for the promised deliverance
