I. Set apart unto God - Num. 5-6

- 1. Redeemed from bondage in Egypt
 Exodus records this deliverance
 They now belong unto God Num. 3:12-13
- 2. Cleansed from all Defilement Num. 5
 Physical defilement 5:1-5
 Such as: Leprosy or contact with Dead
 Reduce threat of spreading disease
 Moral defilement 5:6-10
 Dealing with sin confession & cleansing
 Make restitution when we wrong someone
 Dealing with suspicion 5:11-31
 When accused of immorality
- Set apart unto God Num. 6:1-21
 Nazarite vow Time of special consecration
 All vows before God are sacred
 Such as our wedding vows
 All vows are to be taken seriously
 Psalm 15:4; Matthew 5:33-37
- 4. Blessed of God Num. 6:22-27
 Priest gives God's blessing to the people

II. Worshiping God - 7:-10:10

- Worship at the Tabernacle 7:1-89
 Leaders of Israel bring their offerings
 Wagons & oxen for transporting 7:1-9
 Vessels for use in worship 7:10-14
 Animals for sacrifice 7:15-17

 princes brought same offering 7:18-82
 Summary of 12 days' offering 83-88
 God accepts offering at dedication 88-89
 God accepts the offering of Christ Heb. 10
 At the heavenly sanctuary He offers His blood
 Heb. 10:11-24 only acceptable sacrifice before
 God
- 2. Worship under God's Light 8:1-4 Lamps are lit in the Tabernacle True worship is in the light of Jesus Christ
- 3. Worship leaders consecrated 8:5-26
 Cleansing & consecrating the Levites
 They lead as representatives of the people
 God has taken them instead of firstborn 16-18
- 4. Worship at the Passover 9:1-14
 God gives instructions for this celebration
 14th day of 1st month celebrate deliverance
 God makes some allowances 6-14
 If unclean use 14th day of 2nd month
 Allow stranger to partake in like manner
 Lord's Supper given at Passover Matt. 26:26-29

III. God's Presence - 9:15-10:10

1. God's Cloud over Tabernacle - 9:15-23
God's presence was seen day& night – 15-16

- People moved when cloud moved 17-23 When it rested they stayed in their camp Jesus promised to be with us always Matt. 28:20; Heb. 11:35
- 2. God will call His people together 10:1-10
 Trumpets blown to call the people together
 For war or for worship and celebration
