Ears to Hear Luke 8

I. Purpose of Hearing – 8:1-3

- Not just ears that function Is our auditory system functioning?
- 2. Not just intelligent reception
 Did you understand the words that were spoken?
- 3. The issue is in your response What do you do with the message you heard?
- Responding to Jesus' teaching 8:1-3
 Jesus went through villages with Good News
 The 12 followed Him
 Certain women followed & supported Him

II. Parables on Hearing – 8:4-21

- 1. Parable of the Sower 4-15 Sower scatters seed in his field Seed falls different kinds of soil – 4-7 Responsiveness of the soil is the issue Path, packed down soil – birds eat the seed Rock outcrop – little topsoil – no root, withers Among thorns – sprang up but choked out Good soil – produced fruit Jesus challenges us to respond – 8 Jesus explains purpose of parables - 9-10 Responsive hearts will understand His words Others will not get the message Jesus explains the parable – 11-15 Seed is the Word of God Harden path - like birds Satan snatches seed Shallow soil – respond but no root, soon wither Among thorns – distracted by other things Good soil - respond by doing what is said
- Parable of a lamp 16-18
 Purpose of a lamp is to give light
 Make use of the light that you are given
 If you use it you will be given more
 If you do not use it you will lose it

III. Hearing & Family - 8:19-21

- 1. Family members come to see Him Opportunity to link hearing & relationships They come to communicate with Jesus
- 2. Jesus is not rude or disrespectful to family Note His care for His mother at the cross
- 3. Point is, relationships need hearing
 If we are in His family we must respond to Him

IV. Hearing and Faith - 8:22-25

- Jesus gives disciples directions 22
 Let us go to the other side of the lake
 They respond: got in a boat, launched forth
- 2. Circumstances change for them 23A storm began with heavy windThe boat began to fill up with water

- Jesus was asleep, they were in Jeopardy
- 3. They awoke Jesus 24
 Master, we perish
 Jesus rebuked the wind & the waves
 There was a calm
- 4. He challenged their faith 25 What had He said to them – in v. 22 Let us go over to the other side of the lake They wondered at His power over nature

V. Unresponsive Hearing – 8:26-40

- Jesus and the demonic man 26-27
 His case was incurable
 Many demons controlled him legion 30
 Over a long period of time 27
 Wore no clothes lived in tombs 27
 Threat to society couldn't be bound 29
- Jesus cast out the demons 28-33
 Demons responded to Jesus 28-31
 They knew He was the Son of God
 They knew He had authority over them
 Don't torment us or send us to the abyss
- 3. Demons allowed to enter pigs 32-34
 Asked for permission to enter herd of pigs
 Jesus allowed that to happen
 Demonstrates the great number of demons
 Demonstrates their destructive force
 Herd ran violently down steep slope into lake
 Keepers of pigs spread the news 34
- 4. People of area come to see 35-37 They viewed the evidence of deliverance Found the man sitting at the feet of Jesus Clothed and in his right mind Heard the story of his healing They asked Jesus to leave their area
- 5. Healed man redirected by Jesus 38-39 Go home and be a witness

VI. Responsive Hearts – 8:40-56

- Jesus & the Synagogue leader 40-42
 Jairus sought Jesus to help his daughter
 She was his only daughter, 12 years old
 She was in bed dying
- 2. An interruption in faith 43-48 In the crowd a woman touched Jesus" robe She had an illness for 12 years Spend all she had on doctors with no help Jesus said "who touched me" No one responded but many in the crowd Woman acknowledged she was healed Jesus comforted & sent her away healed
- 3. Bad news comes to Jairus 49
 Don't bother Jesus because she is dead
- 4. Jesus challenges his faith 50Only believe and she will be made whole
- 5. Family support was no support 51-53

They wept and refused Jesus' promise
She is not dead but is asleep
Laughed him in scorn knowing she was dead
6. Jesus restores the girl to life – 54-56
He put the unbelievers out
Took in parents & 3 disciples - 51
Jesus raised her from the dead
