

David Restored to the Throne 2 Samuel 19:9-21:22

I. Re-uniting Israel – 19:9-40

1. Israel remembers David - 9-10
They begin to talk among themselves
King David saved us from our enemies
Now He has fled out of the land because of Absalom
But Absalom has been killed in battle
We need to regather and bring back the king
2. David challenges tribe of Judah – 11-12
Why are you the last to bring back the king
Are we not related, of the same tribe?
3. David reaches out to Amasa – 13
Are we not related? – Offers him captain
4. Judah unites to restore David – 14-15
They led the procession bringing David back
5. Shimei & Benjamin join Judah – 16-18
Ziba and 1,000 men of Benjamin join in
They help bring David over Jordan with boats
6. Shimei begs David for mercy – 18-20
He bows before David & acknowledges his sin
7. David extends grace to Shimei – 21-23
Over Abishai's demand for death penalty
8. Mephibosheth is reconciled to David – 24-30
Claims he was deceived by Ziba
Submits to David & what he deems right
9. David invites Barzillai to join him – 31-40
He provided for David & his men – 17:27-29
Now he joins David as he crosses Jordan – 31
But he is old, cannot go with David - 32-37
Requests rather his son go with David -37-40
Chimham goes with David
10. Judah & ½ of Israel follow David – 40

II. Israel Defects – 19:41-20:26

1. Jealousy between Israel & Judah – 19:41-43
As to who should lead in restoring David
2. Sheba leads Israel to defect – 20:1-2
He is from Benjamin, a man of Belial
Blew a trumpet calling Israel together
Saying "we have no part in David"
So Israel left David & followed Sheba
3. David returned with Judah to Jerusalem – 3
David provided for 10 concubines as widows
4. David prepares to deal with Sheba – 4-6
He gives Amasa 3 days to assemble troops - 4
When he delays David appoints Abishai - 5-6
This rebellion could be worse than Absalom
5. Amasa joins them & takes the lead – 7-8
He is wearing Joab's officer's garment
6. Joab meets Amasa and kills him – 9 -12
He resumes leadership & pursues Sheba
7. Joab & his troops find Sheba – 13-22
He is taking refuge in city of Abel – 14

They besieged the city & battered the wall – 15

Wise woman reasons with Joab – 16-21

Don't destroy the city for one man

Joab agrees & she delivers Sheba's head - 22

7. Israel & Judah are one nation again – 23-26

Order is restored and leaders are appointed

III. Justice is Executed – 21:1-14

1. The land suffers famine 3 years – 1-2
David asks God for the reason
God says, because Saul slew the Gibeonites
He broke an oath made by Joshua & elders
Joshua 9:15, 26-27
Saul slew them hoping to please God - 2
2. David met with remnant to right things – 3-6
They asked for 7 descendants of Saul
3. David did so but spared Mephibosheth – 7-9
4. He buried bones of Saul & Jonathan – 10-14

IV. War again with Philistines - 14-22

1. David made things right with God – 14
2. With that God gave victory in war – 15
3. David & Israel fought Philistines – 16-22
In battle David became faint, faced death – 16
Abishai slew the giant & saved David – 17
David must never again go into battle
David's men fought again with Philistines – 18-22
