I. Glory & Honor to God - 2 Sam. 22

- 1. David known as warrior, but also a worshipper Many Psalms come out of his own experience
- 2. This psalm comes from Psalm 18
 Celebrates God deliverance from his enemies
 Compare 22:1 with heading of Psalm 18
- 3. Extolling the Lord 2-4
 What God does is based upon who He is
 He is his Rock & his Refuge (strong, safe shelter)
 He is his Deliverer (saves him from his enemies)
- 4. Praising God for His exploits 5-20
 God responded to David's cry miraculously
 Deliverance came with God's mighty power
- 5. God rewarding David's faithfulness 21-30 God's reward is greatest riches we can possess David's faithfulness is due to God's enablement
- 6. Lord's faithfulness to His own 31-51 God never fails those who put their trust in Him

II. David's Success is of God - 23:1-7

- All honor & glory belongs to the Lord 1
 Humble son of Jesse whom God lifted up
 He is anointed of the God of Jacob
- 2. His writings are by God's Spirit 2
- 3. His ability to rule is also from God 3
- 4. God made him a light to his people 4
- 5. God made a covenant with him 5
- 6. It is God who protects him 6-7

III. Honor to Military Heroes - 23:8-39

- 1. David gives honor to his mighty men These men have done heroic exploits
- 2. Three men stand out in battle 8-12
 Adino slew 800 men in one encounter 8
 Eleazer's hand stuck to the sword in battle 9-10
 Shammah stood firm in battle 11-12
- 3. Three men risk their lives for David 13-17
 Two individual heroes from second three 18-23
 Abishai slew 300 men in one encounter 18-19
 Benaiah slew lion-like men & a lion 20
- 4. Honor roll of distinguished warriors 24-39
 Thirty seven men were worthy of special mention
 All mentioned by name & family connection
