I. Dividing the Land – 13:1-7

- God's directions for Joshua 1-7
 Joshua is old but much land to be possessed 1
 Dimensions of land to be possessed 2-6
 Compare God's promise to Abraham
 - Genesis 15:18-21
 - Divide the land and let tribes posses it -6-7God will drive out enemies before each tribe Principle for believers today
 - Christ has won the victory, defeated enemy We must claim the victory in our lives
- 2. Land to be divided for 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ tribes 7

II. Portions Given by Moses – 13:8-33

- 1. Land given to 2 ½ tribes by Moses 8-13 Reuben, Gad & ½ of Manasseh Land taken from Sihon & Og – 8-12
- These tribes did not drive out enemies -13
- Tribe of Levi not given portion 14, 33
 Their inheritance was the Tabernacle 14
 Their inheritance was serving God 33
 They will be given cities to live in Joshua 21
 Cities of Refuge included in this group
- 3. Portion for Reuben 15-23 Portion described with their cities Noted that Israel dealt with Balaam – 22
- 4. Portion for Gad 24-28 Portion described with their cities
- 5. Portion for ½ of Manasseh 29-31 Portion described with their cities
- 6. 2 1/2 tribes on east of Jordan 32

III. Inheritance in Canaan

- 1. Land West of the Jordan 14:1-5
- Joshua & leaders distributed this land -12. It was done by lot -2
- So it is God's inheritance to each tribe 3. Joseph was given double portion -3-4
- Ephraim and Manasseh Genesis 48:4-5
- 4. Land divided as God commanded 5

IV. Portion for Caleb - 14:6-15

- Caleb makes his request 6-12 Request based on the following God's Promise - 6 His faithfulness - 7-8 Moses' oath - 9 His ability to still fight at age 85 – 10-11 Area of the giants and the walled cities
- 2. Request granted by Joshua 13 Gave Caleb the city of Hebron
- 3. Caleb gains his inheritance 14-15

V. Portion for Judah – 15:1-63

- 1. Judah is the tribe of Caleb
- Predicted to be the royal tribe Gen. 49:10
- 2. Boundaries for Judah's territory 1-12 In the southern part of Canaan
- Conquest of Caleb & his family 13-19 Conquered cities of the giants – 13-14 Extended his inheritance – 15-19 One of the few to do so
- 4. list of cities within Judah's land 20-62
- 5. Jebusites not driven out of Jerusalem 63

VI. Portion for Joseph – 16-17

- 1. Portion for Joseph's two sons 16:1-4 Description of land for Joseph's two tribes Located in northern Canaan
- Portion for Ephraim 5-10 Boundaries for Ephraim's inheritance Canaanites not driven out of Gezer – 10
- Portion for Manasseh 17:1-13
 Half of tribe not with land east of Jordan
 Provision for families with no sons 3-6
 Canaanites not driven out of cities 12-13
 Made to pay tribute but not driven out
- Joseph's tribes dissatisfied 14-18
 Complained to Joshua about their portion Note that Joshua is of tribe of Ephraim
 - Joshua challenged them to fight 15-18 Go to the woodlands and cut down trees Go fight against the giants Go fight against those with the chariots Drive out the Canaanites
