## In The Family of God Ephesians 1:3-7

## I. Related to God in Christ - 1:3-4

Our God is the God & Father of Christ – 3
 Notice how Paul refers to God
 Found in other New Testament passages
 Romans 15:6; 2 Corinthians 1:3; 11:31;
 Ephesians 1:17; Colossians 1:3; 1 Peter 1:2-3
 Consider how Jews referred to God in O.T.
 God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
 Exodus 3:15; Genesis 22:32; Acts 3:13
 This reminded them of God's covenant
 Their relationship with God was only through the fathers

Our relationship with God is only in Jesus Christ He established the New Covenant with God – Matt. 26:27-28

Hebrews 9:15 – He also included O.T. saints Paul links it together in Christ – Galatians 3:13-16; 26-29

In Christ we enjoy all of God's rich blessing – 1:3 All spiritual blessings are ours in Christ Paul will enumerate some of them in his epistle Jesus pleased God perfectly – Matt. 17:5; Jn 8:29

- Chosen by God before foundation of world 4
   Being in Christ we are His own chosen people
   All who are in Christ by faith are in God's family –
   John 1:12-13
  - This is God's sovereign choice which He made in eternity
- God also determined to make us holy in Christ 4
   We stand before God loved & without blame in Christ

## II. God's Sovereign Purpose for Us - 4-6

- Holy and without blame before Him in love 4
   This is God's purpose for us in Christ
   That we might be conformed to the image of Christ Rom. 8:29
- Predestined to be adopted as His children 5
   This is God's plan and His eternal will for us
   Greek word is "placing as adult sons" Gal. 4:1-5
   Not just children but adult sons note Heb. 2:10
   It is predetermined, God will bring it to completion
- 3. We might bring glory and honor to Him 6
  That all might know He is a gracious & loving God
  That He might be praised & glorified for His grace
- 4. We might be acceptable to God in Christ 6 Christ is God's beloved, in Christ we are accepted We are His bride and accepted in Him

## III. God's Gracious Provision in Christ – 1:7

- Redemption through His blood Sacrifice of Christ has fully paid penalty of our sin God has bought us back so that we belong to Him
- We have complete forgiveness of all sin There is no condemnation to those who are in Christ – Rom. 8:1
- 3. We do not merit this, it is all of His grace God's grace is unlimited in its riches
