Rise and Fall of Gideon Judges 7:16-9:57

I. A Decisive Victory - 7:16-25

- 1. Gideon divides his men in 3 groups 16
 Each has a trumpet, empty pitcher & a torch
- Torch was covered until a signal 17-19
 When Gideon blew his trumpet they blew theirs
 Told to shout, The sword of the Lord & Gideon
 Were to brake the pitcher & let the light shine
- 3. They surrounded camp & did as told 20-21 Blew trumpets shouted & showed their light
- 4. Midianites in fear killed each other 22-25 Other men of Israel helped in destroying enemy

II. A Wise Leader - 8:1-23

- Dealt with complaint of Ephraim 1-3
 Ephraim complained, they were not included
 God had reduced the force to 300 men
 Gideon convinced them of their importance
- Dealt with those who would not help 4-21 Men of Succoth & the men of Penuel Gideon went on to victory with his 300 men Came back to chastise those who would not help
- 3. Refused to accept position as king 22-23 God was king, Gideon was only the deliverer

III. An Unwise Choice - 8:24-32

- Gideon requested gold from spoils 24
 People were happy to give him what he asked
- 2. They willingly gave to their hero 25-26 A large amount of gold and other items
- 3. Gideon made an ephod with the gold 27 Put it in his city & Israel came to worship it
- 4. Israel had rest 40 yrs under Gideon 28
- 5. Gideon had many wives & 70 sons 29-31
- 6. Died and buried in his home town 32

IV. An Ambitious Son - 8:33-9:6

- After Gideon's death Israel sinned 8:33-35
 Worshipped Baal & departed from the Lord Did not treat Gideon's family well
- 2. God allows internal distress to come 9:1-6 From within Gideon's own family
- 3. Abimelech, a son by a concubine 8:30,31
- 4. Supported by his Mother's family 9:1-6
 He convinced them to make him king 9:6
 Hired unscrupulous men to follow him 9:4
- 5. He killed all but one of brothers 9:5

V. A Prophetic Response - 9:7-21

- Jotham warned men of Shechem 7
 God will deal with you and with Abimelech
- 2. He gave a parable of the trees 8-15 When other trees refused to reign, bramble did
- 3. God will right wrongs that are done 16-20 God will turn Abimelech against Shechem God will turn Shechem against Abimelech
- 4. Jotham fled from his brother Abimelech 21

VI. A Prophecy Fulfilled - 9:22-57

- 1. Abimelech reigned 3 years over Israel 22
- 2. God sent an evil spirit to divide 23-24 God avenged wrong done to Gideon's family
- 3. Gaal led Shechem against Abimelech 25-29
- 4. Zebul reports to Abimelech 30-33
- 5. Abimelech besieges city of Shecham -34
- 6. Abimelech destroys Shecham 35-49
- 7. Abimelech is killed at Thebez 50-57 A woman drops a millstone on his head God brings vengeance on Abimelech
